Job Description –

- Maintain lines of communication with VSA's BOD, Executive Director, coaching staff (including DOC-Girls), club administrator and most importantly, our members.
- Manage day to day functions of the select program.
- Recruit, select, train and evaluate paid coaching staff for the select program.
- Evaluate, train and manage all coaches on staff in the select program.
- Assist Academy Director in recruitment and placement of Academy coaches.
- Resolve any coach/player, coach/parent conflicts in the select program.
- Promote, manage and oversee the tryout process and selection for the boys' side of the select program.
- Consistently develop and implement age group curriculums U9 – U19 (Academy & Select).
- Promote VSA to the club's constituents and prospects.
- Speak and participate in meetings of membership.
- Organize and plan workshops, seminars and other types of education programs to be presented to the club's constituents, league meetings and schools.
- Attend regional and national coaching symposiums, seminars, workshops, and licensing courses as directed by the Executive Director
- Report monthly to the BOD in writing all updates, changes and new ideas.
- Act as a liaison with key stakeholders in the game of soccer, including referees, parents, school administrators, and the private sector.
- Create short and long term plans.
- Promote the yearly events VSA hosts.



- Observe and evaluate practice sessions as appropriate and offer guidance where necessary.
- Be the contact person for any coaching issues, including training, concerns, disputes and report all relevant matters to the BOD and Executive Director.
- Help organize, manage and oversee all Showtime Summer and Winter League operations.
- Run preseason meetings with all coaches and answer all questions pertaining to you from parents.
- Actively participate in school outreach program by conducting PE classes in soccer for local schools.
- Be an easily accessible person that maintains good rapport with coaches, parents and players.
- Assist in all general administration work as directed by the executive director.
- Other duties as assigned by the BOD or executive director.
- Create and maintain networks with surrounding clubs.
- Develop Club Coach and team coach season schedules.
- Conduct coach and player evaluations.
- Conduct staff meetings at least quarterly.
- Assist all teams with tournament schedules, preparations and placement.
